The Town of Greece Police Department provides residents an opportunity to dispose of unwanted pharmaceutical wastes. This may include controlled substances, outdate, unwanted, over the counter medications or any pharmaceutical waste that is no longer needed, wanted or has passed its expiration date. For large quantities, please call 585-581-4033 to schedule an appointment.

Disposing of your pharmaceutical waste properly protects our environment and decreases the chance of misuse.

The collection receptacle is for residential pharmaceutical wastes ONLY. Pharmacies, veterinarians, any other pharmaceutical business wastes, needles, syringes and other sharp instruments will not be accepted.

Privacy Issue: The medications and containers will be incinerated under the supervision of Law Enforcement. You may block out any personal information on containers if you choose but it is not necessary.
